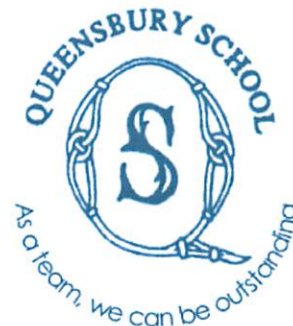

At Queensbury School our staff, governors, parents and carers all recognise that the education of our students is a partnership between us.

In addition we also expect our parents, carers and visitors to keep our students safe by adhering to the school's request to park safely outside the school premises and around the locality of the school, during morning and afternoon collections.

Should any of the below occur **on school premises** or **in connection with school**, the school may feel it is necessary to take action by contacting the appropriate authorities.

- Any inappropriate behaviour.
- Using loud or offensive language or displaying temper.
- Threatening in any way, a member of staff, visitor, fellow parent/carer or child.
- The use of physical, verbal or written aggression towards another adult or child.

In cases where the unacceptable behaviour is considered to be a serious and potentially criminal matter, the concerns will in the first instance be referred to the Police. This will also include anything that could be seen as a sign of harassment of any member of the **school or community**.

Parents/Carers can sign a 'promise' that they will drive and park carefully and considerately around the school (should they need to bring a car to school).

Please help us by completing the attached Parking Promise. By returning your signed undertaking to keep parked cars away from the area outside of school you are protecting the lives of all the students who attend our school. Additionally, you will be promoting considerate parking in the community. Hopefully your example will encourage other parents/carers to do the same.

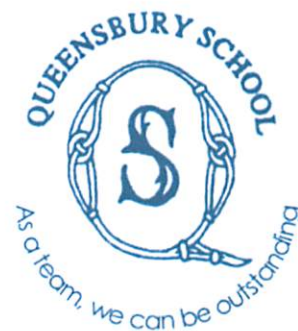

## Parents' Parking Promise

Queensbury School is keen to promote considerate parking and asks all parents to consider the local residents and promise:

- Never to park across drives, even for a few minutes
- Never to park on pavements in a way which prevents pedestrians, disabled users or parents with buggies from using the pavement
- Never to park on corners and prevent a clear view for those crossing the road
- Never to stop on Zig Zag lines or the Zebra Crossing, even for a few minutes
- Never to park in such a way as to block the road and prevent emergency vehicle access
