Road Safety Week 18th to 22nd November 2019

It is National Road Safety Week, next week in school and various activities will take place. Thought for the Week, PSHE lessons and Key Stage Assemblies will focus on Road Safety.

There will be a whole school poster competition running throughout the week – the focus this year is ‘Safer parking’. Our School Council representatives will judge posters on Friday 22nd November and the winners from each Key Stage will be announced in assemblies the following week.

On Monday and Tuesday, classes will participate in sessions run by our local PCSO’s and myself on being safe travellers.

On Tuesday, we hope to be having a double decker bus on the School car park, from National Express, some students will receive a lesson whilst on the bus about good behaviour and safety.

Throughout the week 7V and some Food Technology, classes will be making traffic light biscuits to sell during break times, 20p per biscuit.

As part of Road Safety Week, we hope to assess each class on their road safety knowledge and ability. Some classes will have questionnaires to complete, whilst others may use the road and traffic lights on our school playground. The assessments will take place either during the Road Safety Week or later in the school year.

Friday will be a NON UNIFORM DAY with the focus on ‘traffic lights’ our student council has suggested that students try and wear traffic light colours for the day.
