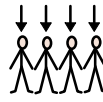




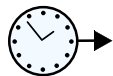
Covid 19 Test at Queensbury School

will not hurt me.



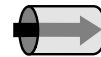
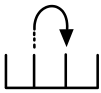
For the test, the person will need to place



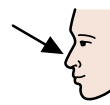
a cotton stick in my mouth and touch the

Next the cotton stick will be placed inside my



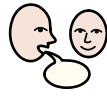
nose and touch on the left and right sides.



The test will not hurt, but it may make



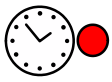
my eyes water a little.

the person doing the test.



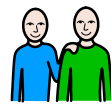
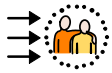
After the test, I may have to wait a few
