

# Key Stage 4 KEY HEADLINE INFORMATION:

Despite the Covid-19 situation and the DfE's Algorithm, Queensbury was recognised for our year on year increasing achievement at GCSE therefore, this year's Grades were higher than predicted.

At GCSE/Level 1 accreditation, students this year out performed those last year by achieving greater numbers of GCSE qualifications. This year, Year 11 students achieved 10 Grade 5 GCSE qualifications between them.


The 2020 OVERALL PASS RATE for GCSE/Level 1 accreditation was 99.3%. Which was an increase compared to 97% last year, and 94.2% the previous year.



#### GCSE PERFORMANCE AGAINST PREDICTIONS:

#### In the 2020 Year 11 cohort of 37 students, all students achieved at least one qualification at either Entry Level or GCSE/Level 1.

- 25 students (67.6%) achieved at least 1 GCSE/Level 1 qualification, which is an increase on last year's results of 20 students.
- 12 students (32.4%) achieved 7 or more GCSE/Level 1 qualifications, compared with 6 students last year.
- 6 students (16.2%) achieved 8 GCSE/Level 1 qualifications.
- 4 students (10.8%) achieved 9 GCSE/Level 1 qualifications.
- GCSE English Language 14 students entered ALL achieved as expected.
- GCSE English Literature 10 students entered ALL achieved as expected.
- GCSE Mathematics 13 students entered 2 achieved ABOVE expected, 11 as expected.
- GCSE Combined Science: TRILOGY 8 students entered 7 achieved ABOVE expected, 1 AS expected.
- GCSE Biology 5 students entered ALL achieved AS expected.
- GCSE Chemistry 5 students entered ALL achieved AS expected.
- GCSE Physics 5 students entered ALL achieved AS expected.
- GCSE Art 11 students entered 6 achieved ABOVE expected, 5 AS expected.
- GCSE Religious Studies 14 students entered 13 achieved AS expected, 1 student failed.
- GCSE D&T 8 students entered ALL achieved AS expected.
- ICT Level 1 Certificate 15 students entered 2 achieved ABOVE expected, 13 achieved AS expected.




- 15.5% of students achieved ABOVE expected in GCSE/ Level 1 accreditation.
- 83.8% of students achieved AS expected in GCSE/Level 1 accreditation.
- NO students achieved BELOW expected in GCSE/Level 1 accreditation.
- 0.64% of students failed to achieve the GCSE/Level 1 accreditation they were entered for.

## Summary

- In the 2020 Year 11 cohort, all students achieved at least one qualification at either GCSE/Level 1 or Entry Level.
- At GCSE, students this year out performed grades achieved last year by achieving higher grades in all GCSE subjects.
- The 2020 overall pass rate for Entry Level accreditation was 100%.
- 25 students achieved at least 1 GCSE/Level 1 qualification an increase from last year.
- 12 students achieved 7 or more GCSE/Level 1 qualifications 50% increase on last year.
- At GCSE, the Combined Science TRILOGY results were particularly strong with 88% of students achieving better than expected.
- At GCSE, Maths results were better than expected with 15% of students achieving above predictions.
- 10 students achieved the newly introduced GCSE English Literature.
- 13 students achieved the GCSE Religious Studies FULL course.
- 5 students achieved GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics, therefore leaving Queensbury with 3 separate GCSE Science qualifications.
- At GCSE Resit, one student managed to achieve the GCSE English Language accreditation on his third attempt and therefore will leave Queensbury with the required Grade 4.
