AQA Language Assessment Objectives:

- AO1-Identify and interpret explicit and implicit information and ideas.
- A02- Explain, comment on and analyse how writers use language and structure to achieve effects.
- AO3- Compare writers' ideas and perspectives across two or more texts.
- AO4- Evaluate texts critically and support this with appropriate textual references.
- AO5- Communicate clearly, effectively and imaginatively.
- AO6- Accurate punctuation/range of sentences for effect.
- AO7: Demonstrate presentation skills in a formal setting
- AO8: Listen and respond appropriately to spoken language, including to questions and feedback on presentations
- AO9: Use spoken Standard English effectively in speeches and presentation.

Stimulus articles/extracts have been suggested for each unit. However, these should be only used as guidance. The teacher should choose material (often based on student interest) to engage the students.
