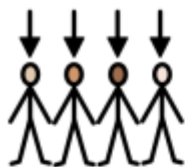

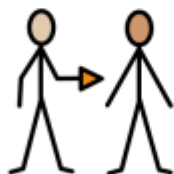

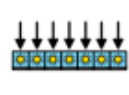

Interventions are also available.








