Established in November 2022, the PTA brings together parents, staff, and governors who work collaboratively to plan, fundraise and deliver a wide range of enriching experiences that go beyond the classroom.

Thanks to the time, energy and commitment of the PTA, pupils have benefitted from a diverse programme of celebrations, workshops and whole-school events. These have included cultural and community celebrations such as Chinese New Year, Eid, Pride, Day of the Dead, Black History Month and Martin Luther King Day, helping pupils to learn about traditions, history and diversity in a practical and engaging way.

The PTA has also supported memorable whole-school events including Easter egg hunts, Bonfire Night, Halloween celebrations, Christmas and Summer fetes, and World Book Day. Funding has helped ensure that all pupils can take part, whether through prizes, activities, performances or special treats such as ice creams for every child. Enrichment funding has also enabled experiences such as author workshops, craft clubs for parents and children, and themed learning days linked to national events, including the King's Coronation.

In addition to supporting pupil enjoyment and learning, the PTA actively promotes teamwork, community spirit and pupil leadership. Events such as the Christmas fete have encouraged older students to plan and run stalls, with friendly competition and shared rewards helping to build confidence and initiative.

Above all, the PTA's work enriches school life by creating joyful memories, celebrating diversity and ensuring pupils feel included and valued. We are incredibly grateful to everyone involved for their ongoing dedication, creativity and enthusiasm, and we look forward to many more events that continue to make a positive difference for our school community.

We are always keen to welcome new members, and no previous experience is needed. Parents/ carers can be involved as much or as little as they like – whether that means attending occasional meetings, helping at events when available, sharing ideas, or simply staying informed. Every contribution, big or small, helps to make a positive difference.
